



Eco creek sites a hit for family lifestyles

MORE land will be released at Seaside on the Tweed Coast in coming weeks.

The master-planned residential estate is being developed by Seaside Living and the latest blocks to hit the market will feature creekside land.

Seaside marketing manager Zel Creswick said the lots were geared towards being family and green friendly.

"Seaside is the ideal address for those who want to live in an environmentally responsible eco-sustainable, family-oriented master-planned community close to the beach, shops,
